**Lillian Faderman** is an American historian whose books on lesbian history and LGBT history have earned critical praise and awards. The New York Times named three of her books on its "Notable Books of the Year" list. In addition, The Guardian named her book, Odd Girls and Twilight Lovers, one of the Top 10 Books of Radical History. She was a professor of English at California State University, Fresno (Fresno State) and a visiting professor at University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA). Faderman has been referred to as "the mother of lesbian history" for her groundbreaking research and writings on lesbian culture, literature, and history. She published Naked in the Promised Land in 2003 for which she won the Bill Whitehead Triangle award for Lifetime Achievement and the Lambda Literary Award. (Source: Wikipedia).
